Q2. A paper mill on the Cauvery River discharges untreated effluents. Its private production cost is ₹50 per tonne of paper. However, downstream farmers lose ₹20 per tonne worth of irrigation water quality, and fishermen lose ₹15 per tonne in fish catch. (a) Calculate the social cost per tonne. (b) What is the externality? (c) What policy can internalise this externality? [4 marks]
