Q3. For a frequency distribution, Mean = 54 and Median = 52. (a) Find Mode using the empirical relationship. (b) Calculate the arithmetic mean for the following discrete series: X: 10, 20, 30, 40, 50; f: 4, 7, 12, 8, 4. (c) State when to use each measure of central tendency. [6 marks]
