Q2. Evaluate $8!/(6! \times 2!)$. *[2 marks]*

Q3. In how many ways can a team of 3 be selected from 8 people? *[2 marks]*

Q4. How many 3-digit numbers can be formed using the digits 1 to 9 if no digit is repeated? *[3 marks]*

Q5. How many 4-letter codes can be formed using the 26 letters of the alphabet if repetition of letters is allowed? *[3 marks]*

Q6. Find the number of arrangements of the letters of the word STATISTICS. [4 marks]

Q7. How many chords can be drawn through 15 points lying on a circle? [4 marks]

Q8. Verify Pascal's identity for $n=5$, $r=2$, i.e. confirm that ${}^5C_1 + {}^5C_2 = {}^6C_2$. [3 marks]

Q9. How many arrangements of the letters of the word ORANGE are there in which the vowels (O, A, E) always occur together? [5 marks]

Q10. A committee of 4 is to be selected from 5 men and 6 women, with at most 1 man on the committee. Find the number of ways. [5 marks]
